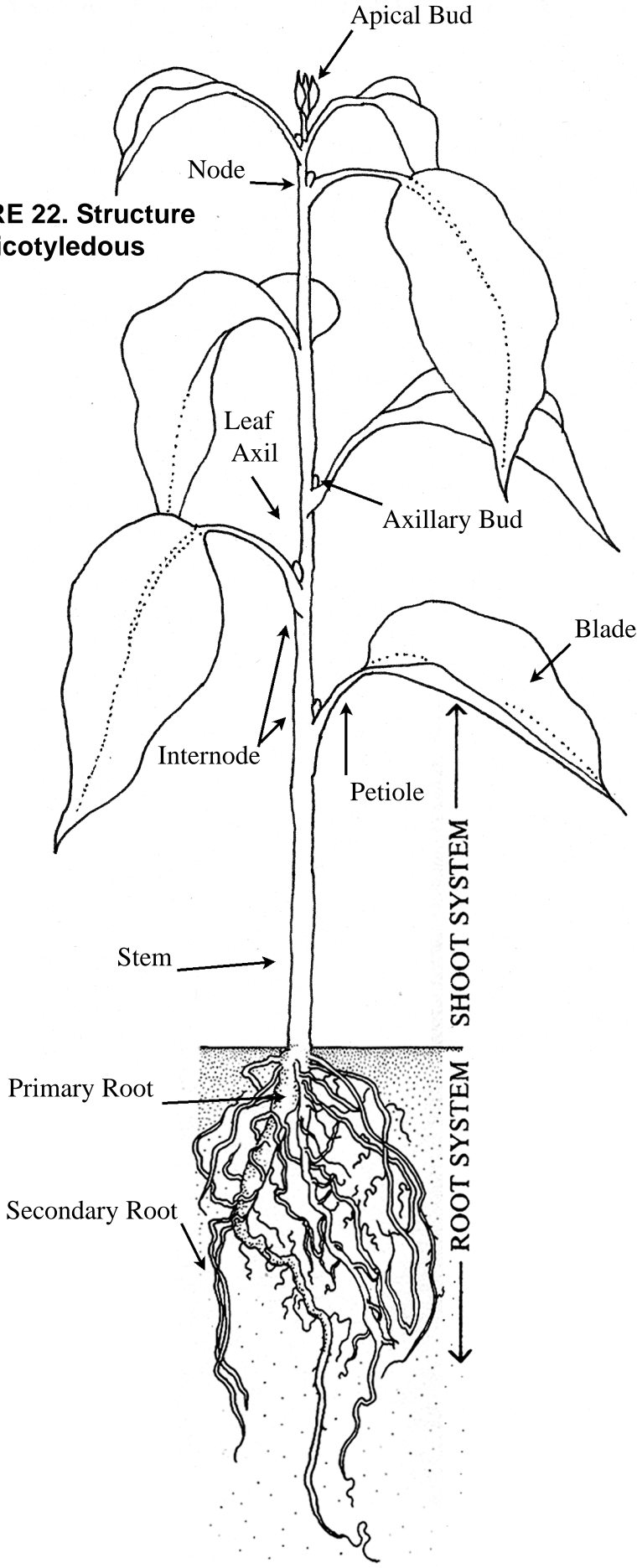


**FIGURE 22. Structure of a dicotyledonous angiosperm.**

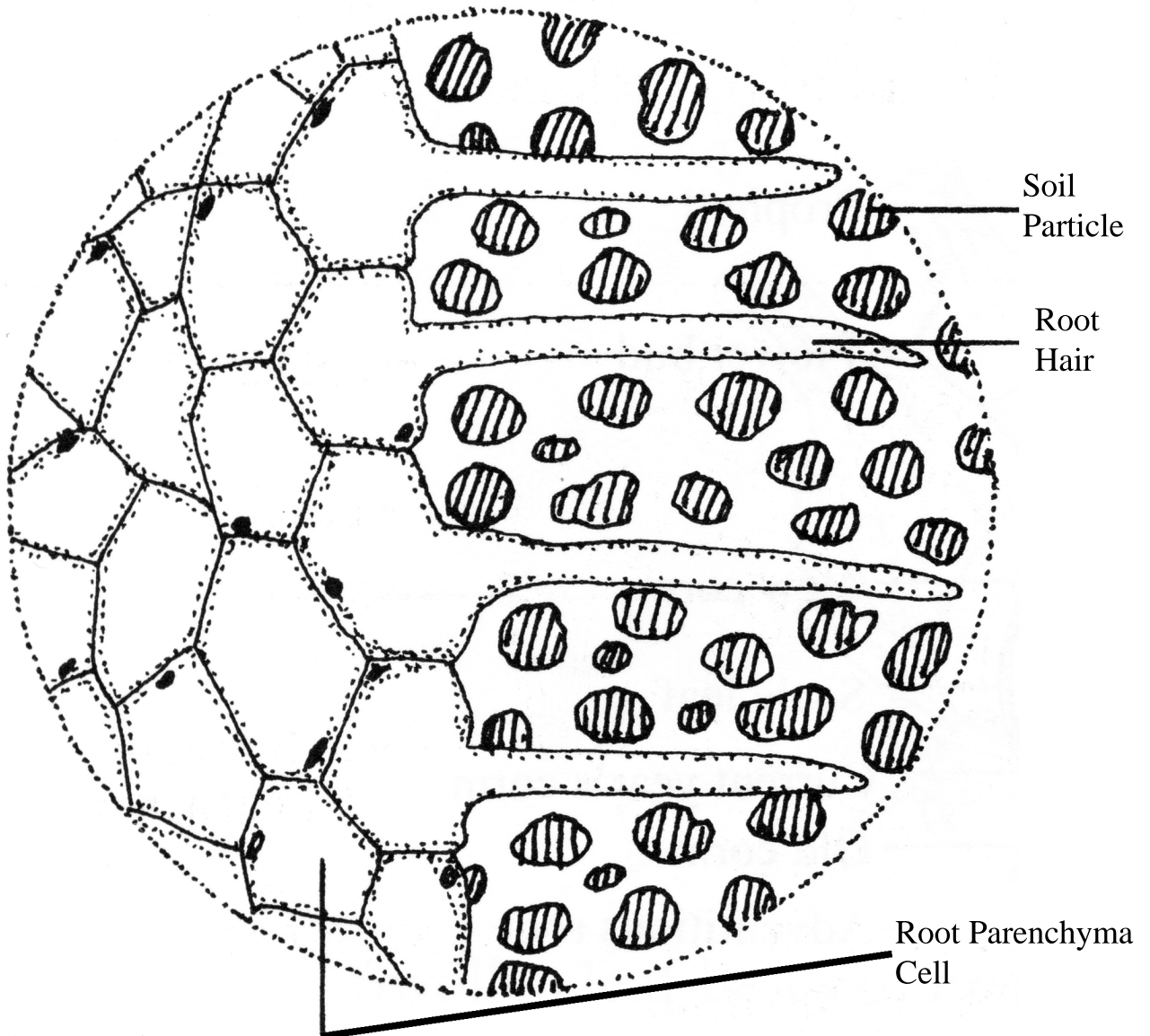
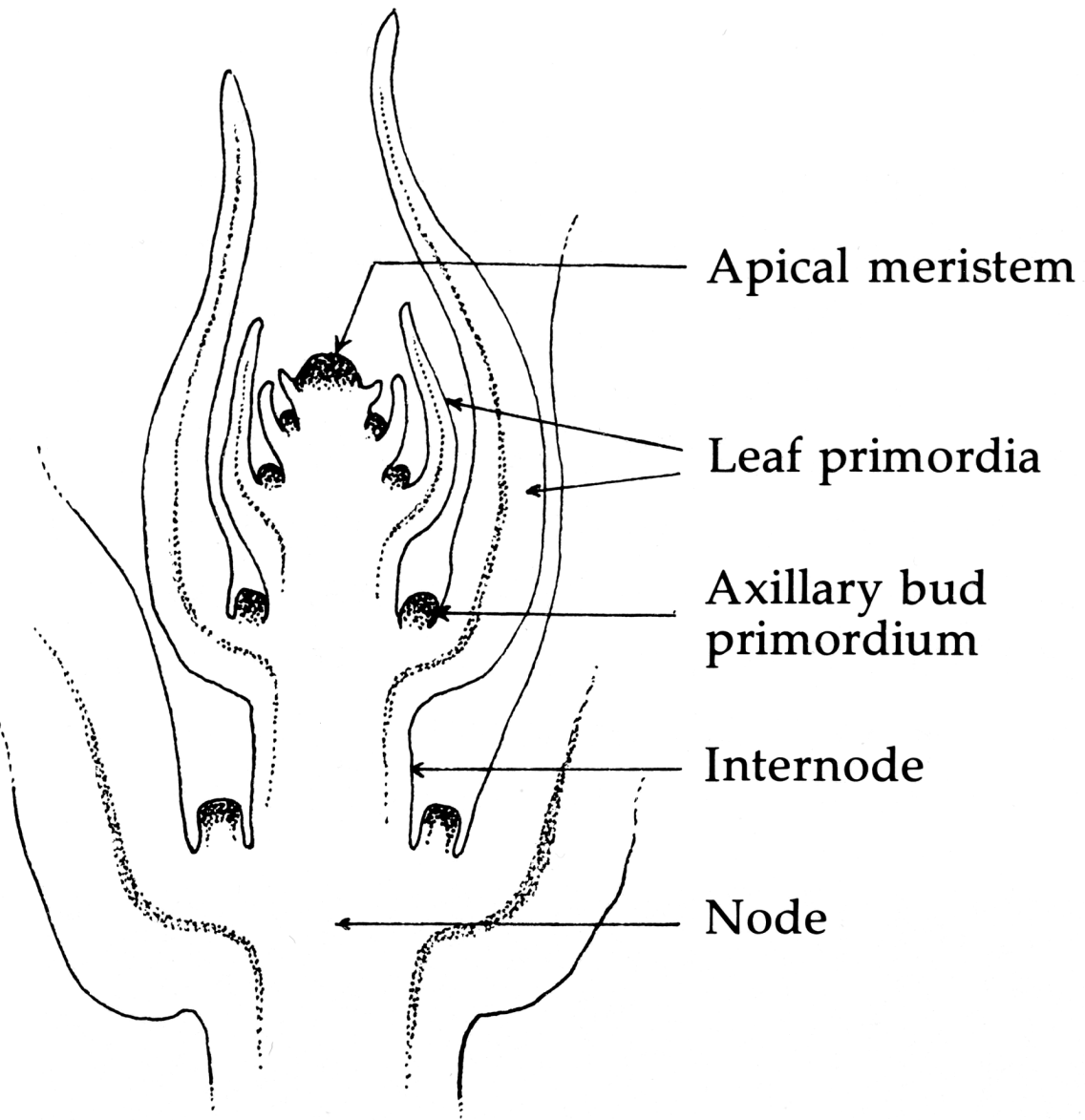
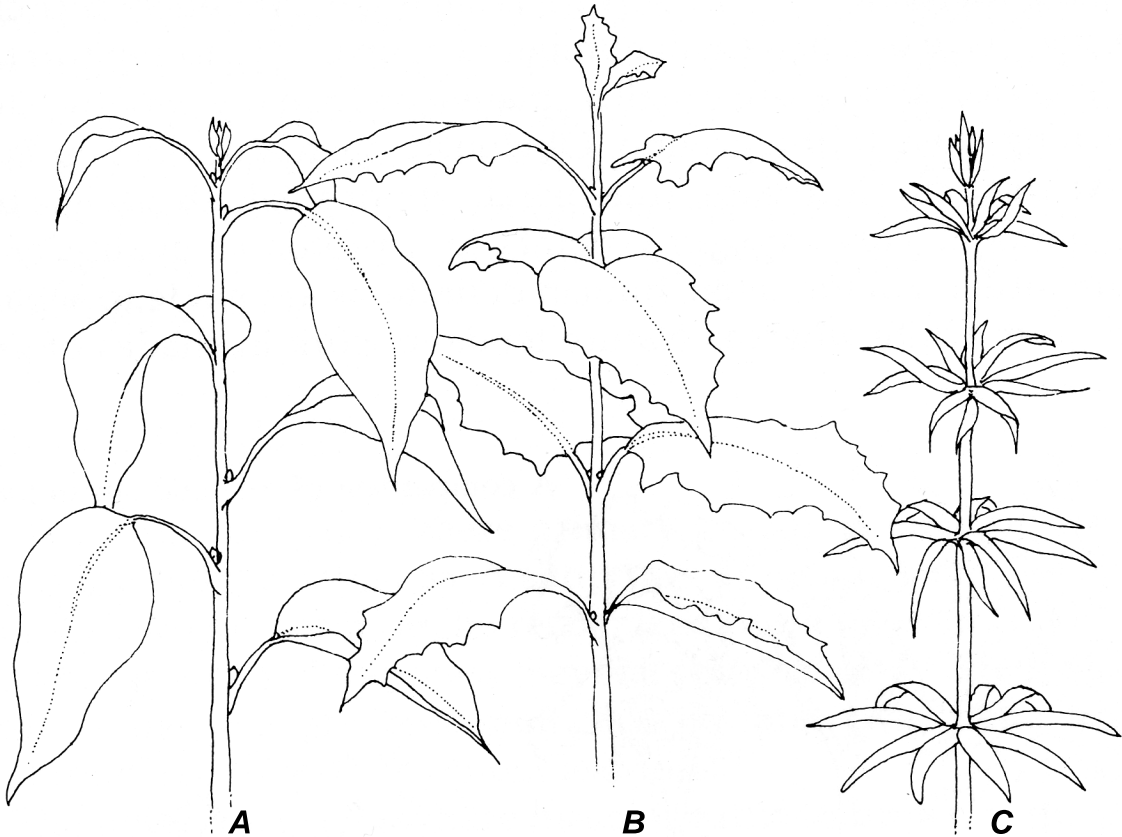


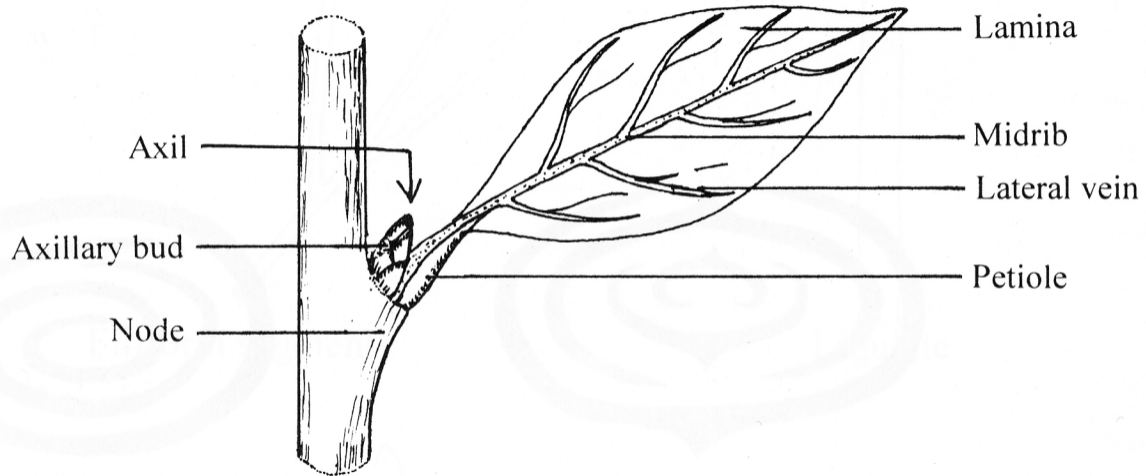
Figure 23. Detail of root hair structure.



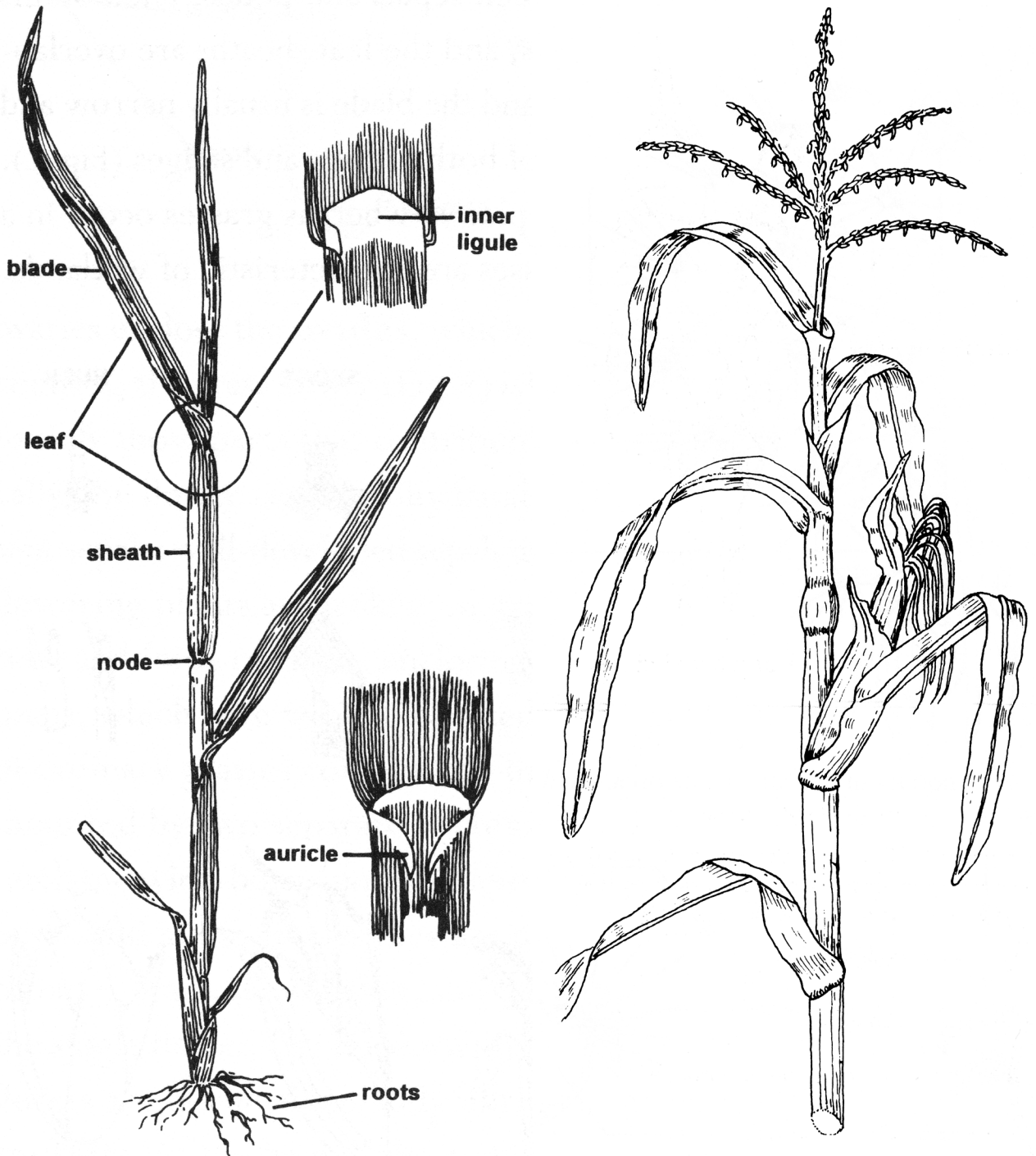
**FIGURE 24.** Structure of a dicotyledonous apical bud.
